Data Loggers, Tracking Devices etc. according to IATA DGR 2024 (65. edition)

In sea and road transport on basis of the UN Model Regulations a new Section 5.5.4 was introduced for the usage of data loggers, tracking devices or similar equipment.

The ICAO Dangerous Goods Panel (ICAO DGP) and also IATA had intended to include this new regulation under the exceptions of 1.2.7.1 (i) of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations.

The implementation was rejected by the deciding ANC (Air Navigation Commission).

This means that the present regulations for such devices continue to be valid and that for lithium cells and batteries the respective requirements of Packing Instruction 967 Section II respective 970 Section II need to be considered.

Note:

In air transport there is a prohibition for active data loggers, tracking devices or similar equipment containing lithium cells/batteries according to Section I of Packing Instruction 967 respective 970.
