Waste / Disposal / Recycling of lithium cells/batteries in air transport according to IATA DGR 2024 (65. Edition)

The shipping and transport of lithium cells/batteries as waste (meaning for disposal or recycling) is only allowed in air transport when the approval of the state of departure and of the state of operator is on hand.

This requirement is stated in Special Provision A183 in subsection 4.4.

Here the text of A183:

Waste batteries and batteries being shipped for recycling or disposal are forbidden from air transport unless approved by the appropriate national authority of the State of Origin and the State of the Operator.
