

Information for Craft Businesses

Validity: in all ADR member states

If you are located in a non-ADR state you must take the respective current regulations from the national provisions.

If you answer all of the following questions with YES, you can make use of this ADR exemption for craft businesses!

1. Do you perform your working activity in an ADR mem- ber state?		
2. Are you on your way in connection with your main ac- tivity (e.g. to the building site or to a demonstration at the client's)?		
 3. Do you carry lithium cells and/or lithium batteries: loose and/or installed in equipment and/or packed with equipment in your vehicle, which you need in order to perform your working activity? 		
4. Are the lithium cells/batteries4.a. protected so as to prevent short circuits?		
4.b. properly packed?		
4.c. secured in the vehicle, so as to prevent shifting or falling?		
d. protected from damage through other transported goods?		
5. Is it ensured that the damaged lithium cell/battery are if possible packed into fireproof packagings?

6. Were the limited quantities met?:		
If only lithium cells and/or lithium batteries:		
- loose and/or		
- installed in equipment and/or		
- packed with equipment		
are carried, then the limited quantity is 333 kg net weight		
of the lithium cells and batteries.		
When other dangerous goods are carried along with the transport, also in relation to the main business activity and its performance, it must be determined according to the 1.000 Points Rule whether the carriage is still exempt (up to 1.000 points) or whether it requires mandatory labeling (more than 1.000 points).		

If your answer to one of the above questions is "NO", then the craft business regulation must NOT be applied!
